There have been many more advances in the past 20 years from our wonderful website, business portals with certain companies, and great programs like Dropbox that keep everything accessible. How in the world did we do anything without a camera phone?!

When Mike and Mike hired me, I was in charge of Quality Assurance for a large home builder.
